# Lakeshore through the years...

#### October 1999

Lakeshore Community Church opened its doors under the leadership of Pastor Dan Helps in the gymnasium of Bright's Grove Public School.

#### **Summer 2001**

We purchased 18+ acres of property on Old Lakeshore Road. The property was serviced and a 5.8-acre portion was set aside as the possible future home of Lakeshore Community Church.

#### **Summer 2003**

Lakeshore Community Church purchased a building at 2695 Hamilton Road, used for offices, meetings and outreach until it was sold in 2011.

### **April 2003 – May 2010**

Our Future Development Committee researched building designs and alternative building sites in Bright's Grove.

# May, 2010 to December, 2011

Construction of the existing church building.

## **December 24, 2011**

First service in our existing building.

## January, 2012 - December, 2016

Lakeshore Community Church experienced steady growth in numbers.

# January, 2017 - Present

Lakeshore Community Church began a two-service format on Sunday mornings. A building committee is put in place to pursue a building expansion plan that will facilitate current and future church growth.

# Key Numbers

- Projected cost of building expansion will be \$3.4 million dollars
- Existing mortgage as of October, 2019 is approximately \$275,000
- Projected mortgage after campaign ends will be approximately \$1.5 million dollars to be steadily paid off in future years



- Capital campaign goal is to raise \$2.3 million dollars over 3 years
- Collect all pledge sheets as soon as possible
- Begin construction by Spring, 2021 depending on campaign progress
- Participation from everyone based on equal sacrifice (not equal giving)
